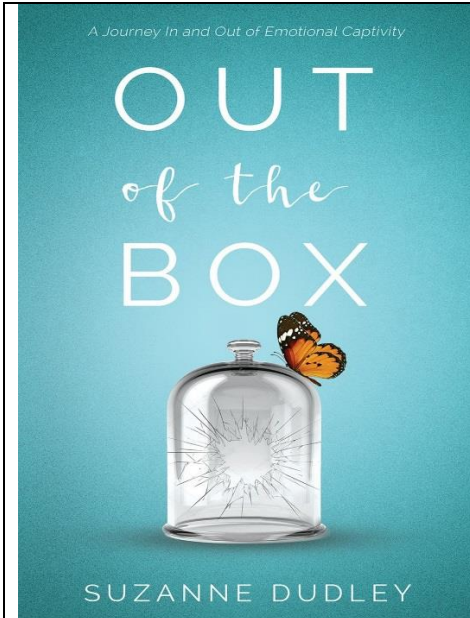

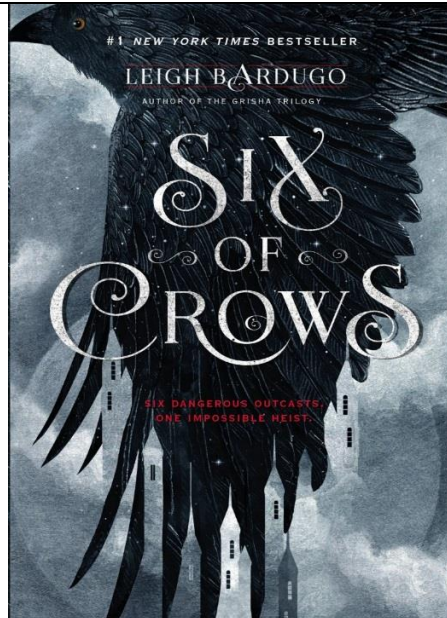


## SECONDARY SCHOOL WRITING COMPETITION TOPICS

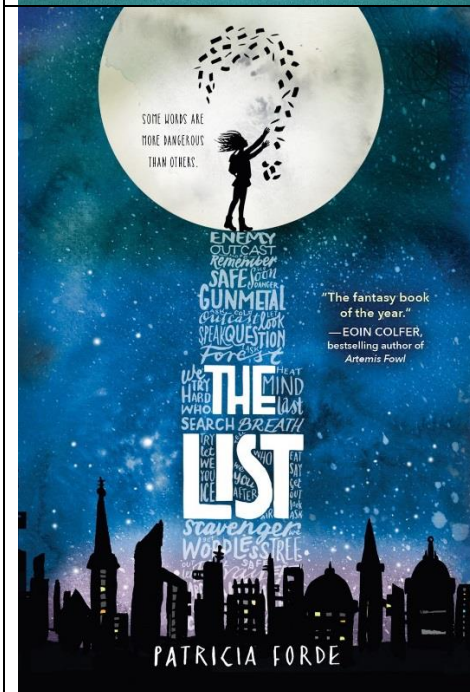

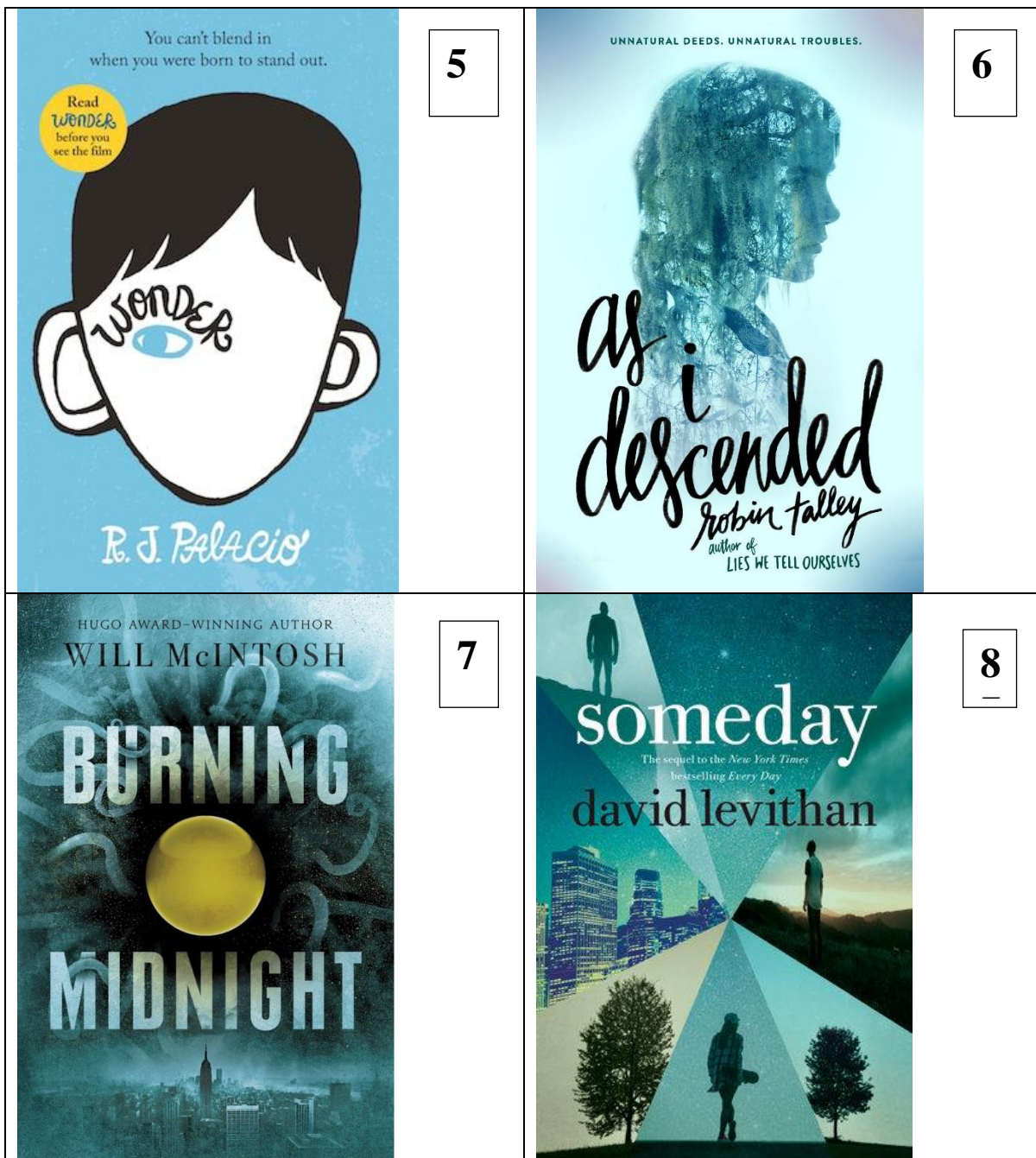
